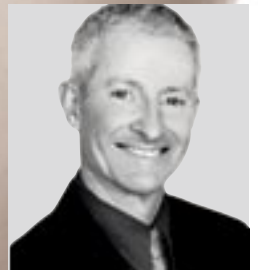


## Enjoy Lush Locks
